I believe the Five Precepts are as relevant today as they were in 1915, when used by Usui to begin his teaching life, but it was in 1922, when he went to meditate on Mt Karama, that he personally *experienced* the life force he called Reiki. I think it's one of life's great paradoxes, that we spend so much time and energy attending courses, reading books, watching videos etc. trying to find our personal/spiritual path – when the 'kingdom of heaven' is within! At some point we realise, all those courses, books and videos can be just a distraction from the real inner work. Your regular daily practice progresses that deepening experience. And sometimes that's easier to say than to do; what a weird year 2017 has been! I sometimes felt my life and all the plans and preparations, were thrown up in the air, sifted and sorted, only to descend in new arrangements; and, as is often the case, when I

ignored the changing realities, change was imposed. It all worked out OK - but so often, different to my plans and expectations.

And what of 2018?

Once again I'm intending to create the best possible balance between my private and public life; trekking in Nepal in Apr, visiting Zimbabwe in Sept. I'll provide the following classes and will respond to requests for additional classes. If re-elected, I'll continue as chairman of the Reiki Association (WA) and participating in some of their volunteering activities.

Some 7 or 8 years ago, Phyllis discovered she had breast cancer, the possibility that she may die precipitated questions of who or what would be her successor? I don't think those question have been formally answered but there has been an apparent increase in the number of national and regional groups taking greater control of their own affairs.

Perhaps the biggest change to affect complementary practitioners in WA will be as a consequence of the WA government finally beginning the process of legislating the 'National Codes of Conduct'. First determined in 2008, they define the required conduct of complementary health practitioners in public practice. Practitioners who transgress these codes may be banned from continuing to practice in public. One significant omission in the proposed draft is the absence of any requirement for a person to belong to an appropriate association, if there is no assessment of the practitioner's training, qualifications or experience, then any person can claim to be any type of practitioner; this is not possible in other healthcare sectors, eg doctors, nurses etc.
